Safety precautions

Please be sure to carefully read and observe the following "safety precautions" before use, so as to avoid causing harm and bring unnecessary property damage to you and others.

The meaning of the sign



Refer to the contents needed to be noticed.

Precaution upon death or serious injury caused by faulty operations.

Properly use the power plug, and power cord



- Clean the dust on the power plug regularly, so as to avoid bad insulation resulted from dust accumulation, and moisture; fire; as well as electric shock.
- performed Please be sure to insert the power plug in place,

so as to avoid fire or electric shock resulted from short circuit.

 Power shall use sockets with AC 220V and rated value of over 10A alone, so as to avoid fire.



 When cleaning, overhauling or moving, be sure to remove the power plug out of the socket, so as to avoid electric shock and injury.
 Do not unplug the power plug while the cooling fan is running.

 Do not plug or unplug the power plug using wet hands.

so as to avoid electric shock, scald or injury.



- Do not power on when the power cord is tied up,
- so as to avoid scald or fire resulted from overheating. Be sure to use the power cord with opening.
- Please do not damage power lines
- Do not pull the power cord when handling or gathering

Do not damage, process, bend with force, pull, and twist the power cord or use it to hang or hold heavy objects.

so as to avoid fire and electric shock caused by the damages of power cords.

- Do not use broken power cords, power plugs, and loose sockets,
 - so as to avoid fire or electric shock resulted from short circuit. When the power cord is damaged, contact the store or the Agents.
- Do not let the baby lick the power plug, so as to avoid injury or electric shock.



Do not hit the top tray powerfully

Do not sit or drop items on the top tray, so as to avoid electric shock, fire and injury caused by cracks or ruptures of the top tray.





Must be performed

 When an error or failure occurs, stop using it immediately and unplug the power plug from the socket,

so as to get rid of smoking, fire or electric shock. (Abnormal example)

- · Abnormal sound or peculiar smell occurs
- There is abnormal heating of power plug and power cord
- When moving the power cord, the power is intermittent
- Power failure always occurs in the course of using
- When touching, there is feeling of numbness electric shock
- Please stop using it immediately and consult the store or the Agents where you buy products.



Deep-frying cooking is banned,

so as to avoid fire caused by over-high oil temperature.

Prohibited


 Do not place the product in children's reach or use it near pets,

so as to avoid electric shock, scald and injury.



- Don't drip water on the body
- No contact with water with water or short circuit can be avoided.

 Don't use water to clean the body Thus, fire or electric shock resulted from power leakage or short circuit can be avoided.





 Do not carry other objects other than recommended pots on the top tray

- When heating a portable butane fuel stove, liquefied gas bottle, can, hot-water bag, battery, the packing of soft can, tinfoil pot, paper-based packaging with aluminum foil inside, metal spoon, pot cover and other items wrongly, fire, injury, scald and even explosion can be caused due to overheating.
- Do not place flammable items on or near the top tray,

so as to get rid of fire and scald.



 Do not disassemble, repair and modify The product by yourself,

so as to avoid fire, electric shock and injury. For repair, please contact the store or the Agents.



Warning: If the surface is cracked, turn off the appliance to avoid possible shocks.

When heating soup and dishes, water, curry and other liquids,



Must be performed

 reduce power and stir continuously, so as to get rid of scald and injury caused by soup with sudden boiling.



When cooking with fry or bake



Must be performed


- · Do not leave in the course of cooking
- Please reduce preheating fire to avoid excessive heating

Please pay attention to the fire due to less amount of oil used when cooking.



Do not put foreign matters such as pins or wires into the gap between the exhaust port, air suction port and product,

so as to avoid fire, electric shock and injury.





Attention

Precaution upon slight injury or product damage caused by faulty operations.



 When unplugging the power plug, be sure to hold the power plug using hands and do not pull the power cord,

so as to avoid electric shock, short circuit and fire caused by damages of power cords.

 Be sure to unplug power plug when you do not use it for a long time,

so as to get rid of fire and electric shock due to insulation aging.

Do not unplug the power plug while the cooling fan is running.



Prohibited

 Do not make the easily magnetized items close to the product,

so as to avoid eliminating information records about cash card, machine used commutation ticket of automatic ticket checking and cartridge tape due to magnetization,

so as to avoid noise or sound with low volume of radio, television, and hearing aid due to magnetization.



If users using medical pacemakers need use the product, please consult a doctor, so as to get rid of influence on pacemakers due to

performed magnetic line of force.

Safety precaution (continued)



 Do not lay paper, cloth or dust cover on the top tray of the induction cooker,

so as to avoid overheating, failure, smoking and fire due to malfunction of a heater.



 Do not touch the high temperature section in the course of using and just using it,
 so as to avoid scald for touching the high temperature.

so as to avoid scald for touching the high temperature section. Clean the body thoroughly after cooling.



 Please do not use the product for purposes other than cooking.

Prohibited

so as to avoid fire disaster and scald due to abnormal heating and abnormal action.

 Please do not use the product for purposes other than household

The product is designed as a household appliance. It may lead to fire if it's used for purposes other than household.



 Please do not obstruct the exhaust port or air suction port or use your hand, face or other items to approach the exhaust outlet or suction inlet.

so as to avoid fire or scald due to internal overheating of the body.

Please make sure not to pave paper, tablecloth or other items under the air suction port. Please do not put seasoning and other items near the product.

About operation place



 Please do not use the product within water consumption sites or near fire sources,
 so as to avoid short circuit and electric shock.

No contact with water

Prohibited

• Please do not use the product on cushions which are not heatproof,

to avoid fire.

Please do not use the product on narrow canopy frames,

so as to avoid fire and electric shock due to dampness of the power regulating knob and power cord.

 Please do not use the product in a site which is unsteady or slippery,

so as to avoid scald and injury due to drop out.



 Please do not put the pot in unsteady places, so as to avoid scald and injury due to drop out or turnover of the top tray.



 Please do not move when the pot is on the induction cooker's top tray,

so as to avoid scald and injury due to drop out of pots.

In case that the power flexible line is damaged, replacement must be conducted by professionals assigned by manufacturer, maintenance department or similar departments to avoid risk.



 Please do not put the pot on the induction cooker under heating without any anything in it,

to avoid scald and fire due to overheating of the pot



Precautions for use

- Do not use it on other induction cookers. Do not heat any other induction cookers or IH electric cookers on the product, so as to avoid malfunction and failure.
- Do not place radio, television, remote control, telephone and battery next to the product, so as to avoid malfunction and failure.
- Do not use items to hit the corner of the top tray, so as to avoid damages to the top tray.
- Please wipe up water attached outside of the pot and on the top tray before use,
 - so as to avoid overheating or failure due to reduced efficiency of induction cooker.
- Please place the pot in the center of the top tray. Do not place
 it crossing other equipment or use pots exceeding the size of
 top tray.
- so as to avoid malfunction and failure.
- The adjustment of the firepower will be weakened due to different materials, shapes and thicknesses of the pot.
- The setting place of products will be hot due to hot gas exhausted at the back of exhaust ports.
- After finishing heating, operational sounds of fans can still be heard, which is not unusual.

Cool the internal body through fans in the course of using or after using.

Do not unplug the power plug until the fan stops running.

About safety devices

· When an abnormality occurs during cooking, the indicator lamp and buzzer will notify and the heating will stop.


Safety devices	Contents
No pot measuring ability/ small object measuring ability	Indicator lamp for heating will flash or stop heating when using inapplicable pot to heat on the induction cooker; when heating without placing pot; place small objects such as spoon other than pot when heating.
Internal circuit Anti-overheating function	When internal temperature rises, sounds will be made by the buzzer, and the indicator lamp for heating will flash or stop heating. Please turn off the power, and use it again after cooling the body.
Top tray Anti-overheating function	The fire will be automatically adjusted when the pan base temperature rises, and if the temperature continuously raises, the buzzer will ring, the heating indicator lamp will blink and the heating will stop. Please turn off the power, and use it again after cooling the top tray.
Auto stop function	If there is no operation in 2h from the start of cooking, the buzzer will ring and the heating will stop.

Concept of IH heating

Feeding high-frequency current to the heating coil generates magnetic lines of force. When the magnetic lines of force pass through the pan base, eddy current will be generated in the interior of the pan. The eddy current flows and heats up the pan due to the resistance.


IH is the abbreviation of Induction Heating.

Therefore, there are adaptable pots and inadaptable pots for an induction cooker. (→P8)




Name of parts

■ Undersurface




Before use

About operation place

Please keep the product from walls and furniture in a distance as shown in the Figure


 Product overheating or fire may happen if the product is used in narrow places. Please use the product in dry and ventilated places.



■ Identification of adaptable pot

Power cord connecting

- Before connecting the power cord, please verify if the fire regulating knob is switch to the **off** position.
- Please securely insert the power plug into the socket.




Please pour water into the pot and align it to the center of the top tray.




3 Rotate the fire regulating knob

• Please aim to any scale from 1-6




The heating indicator lamp will light up if adaptable pot is identified



Please switch the fire regulating knob to "Off" immediately after identification to stop heating (The pot will be heated if the heating process continues.)

* The adjustment of the firepower will be weakened due to different materials, shapes and thicknesses of the applicable pot.

The heating indicator lamp will light up if inadaptable pot is identified



The pot can't be heated.

* Identification may not void if the top tray has residual heat. Please initiate identification after the top tray cools down.

■ Adaptable and inadaptable pots

There are adaptable and inadaptable pots for an induction cooker, in terms of material, size and shape. For adaptable pot, we recommend the "ceramic cookware designed for IH" manufactured by Iris Ohyama.




Warning

Power cord connecting


- Before connecting the power cord, please verify if the fire regulating knob is switch to the off position.
- Please securely insert the power plug into the socket.



Please pour materials into the pot and align it to the center of the top tray.




- * Please use pot with appropriate materials, sizes and shapes. (→P8)
- **3** Rotate the fire regulating knob to regulate the fire
 - The heating process starts once the heating indicator lamp lights up



* If there is no operation in 2h during the heating process, the buzzer will ring and the heating process will automatically cease. (Heating indicator lamp becomes off.) If the cooking time exceeds 2h, you need to restart.

4 When the cooking is over, please switch the fire regulating knob to "Off"

 When the cooking is over, the heating indicator lamp will become off.



- When the fire regulating knob is not switched to "Off", the heating will not start even if the power cord is connected.
- When the cooking is over, the cooling fan will continue to run
 if the internal temperature is high. Do not unplug the power
 plug until the fan stops running.



Attention

 Please avoid being scalded by the top tray.


Attention

- Please clean the product after the power is switched off, the power cord is disconnected and the main body cools down.
- Please do not clean by water.

Main body and top tray

Please wipe it using a dry cloth which is completely wrung-out


- Upon cleaning, please dip a dry cloth with diluted neutral detergent and wipe out the cloth, and then use the wrung-out cloth the wipe the product.
- If the stains on the top tray are hard to be removed, please use slight liquid cleanser to wipe the top tray.



Air suction port and exhaust port

Turn over the induction cooker, and remove the dust using dust collector


* Failure or overheating may be consequential if the product is used with attached dusts.



- Please do not use xina water, gasoline, acid or alkaline detergent, decolorizer, and domestic synthetic detergent.
- Please apply abrasive powder or scrubbing brush to the parts other than the top tray.
- Please clean the top tray after each use, so as to avoid deformation and stickiness due to smudginess.

Failure removal

Please read this manual in details before sending the product for repair, and check whether the abnormality is caused by any of the following circumstances.



Heating failure (repeated buzzer ringing and repeated twice heating indicator lamp flashing)


